**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF DCP MIDSTREAM, LP  
TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A  
HYDROGEN SULFIDE GAS PIPELINE  
FULLERTON GATHERING SYSTEM  
ANDREWS AND GAINES COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on October 15, 2010, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of DCP Midstream, LP to construct and operate a hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline extension, a 12 inch line from the Fullerton Gas Plant in Andrews County to the New Mexico state line, is hereby approved. DCP Midstream, LP shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of the hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.
