ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST JOHN ALLEN REESE D/B/A A J A COMPANIES (OPERATOR NO. 000351) FOR VIOLATIONS OF STATEWIDE RULES ON THE BEN LAIRD (06471) LEASE, EAST TEXAS FIELD, GREGG COUNTY, TEXAS; LLOYD HEIRS (07443) LEASE, EAST TEXAS FIELD, GREGG COUNTY, TEXAS; AND JNO. LLOYD (07106) LEASE, EAST TEXAS FIELD, GREGG COUNTY, TEXAS

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice the captioned enforcement proceeding was heard by the examiner who has circulated a Proposal for Decision containing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. Having been duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas, those Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are hereby adopted and made a part hereof by reference.

It is accordingly **ORDERED** that, within 30 days from the day immediately following the date this order becomes final:

1. John Allen Reese D/B/A A J A Companies shall clean up and place in compliance with Statewide Rules 3, 8, and 91 [Tex. R.R. Comm'n, 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§3.3, 3.8, and 3.91] the Ben Laird (06471) Lease, East Texas Field, Gregg County, Texas;
2. John Allen Reese D/B/A A J A Companies shall clean up and place in compliance with Statewide Rules 8 and 91 [Tex. R.R. Comm'n, 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 3.8 and 3.91] the Lloyd Heirs (07443) Lease, East Texas Field, Gregg County, Texas;
3. John Allen Reese D/B/A A J A Companies shall clean up and place in compliance with Statewide Rules 3, 8, and 91 [Tex. R.R. Comm'n, 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§3.3, 3.8 and 3.91] the Jno. Lloyd (07106) Lease, East Texas Field, Gregg County, Texas; and
4. John Allen Reese D/B/A A J A Companies shall pay an administrative penalty in the amount of **FORTY THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$40,750.00)**.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Commission that this order shall not be final and effective until 20 days after a party is notified of the Commission's order. A party is presumed to have been notified of the Commission's order three days after the date on which the notice is actually mailed. If a timely motion for rehearing is filed by any party of interest, this order shall not become final and effective until such motion is overruled, or if such motion is granted, this order shall be subject to further action by the Commission. Pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.146(e), the time allotted for Commission action on a motion for rehearing in this case prior to its being overruled by operation of law, is hereby extended until 90 days from the date the order is served on the parties.

Each exception to the examiner's proposal for decision not expressly granted herein is overruled. All requested findings of fact and conclusions of law which are not expressly adopted herein are denied. All pending motions and requests for relief not previously granted or granted herein are denied.

Noncompliance with the provisions of this order is subject to enforcement by the Attorney General and subject to civil penalties of up to \$10,000.00 per day per violation.
