**FINAL ORDER  
CANCELLING ALL OVER-PRODUCTION FOR THE  
DOROTHY HILL LEASE, WELL NO. 2  
PYOTE, SOUTH (6100 SAND) FIELD  
WARD COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 3, 2013, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all over-production for the Dorothy Hill Lease (ID No. 34711), Well No. 2 (API No. 42-475-34218), Pyote, South (6100 Sand) Field (ID No. 73565 400), Ward County, Texas, is hereby canceled.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Dorothy Hill Lease, Well No. 2, shall not be assigned a penalized allowable if the well is capable of producing no more than the top oil allowable for the field of 111 barrels of oil per day and the corresponding casinghead gas limit of 222 MCFPD, regardless of the gas-oil ratio reported for the well on the most recent well test.
