FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING PERMANENT CLASSIFICATION OF  
EL PASO PRODUCTION COMPANY VERA BLACK WELL NO. 8  
AS A GAS WELL IN THE  
BETHANY (COTTON VALLEY) FIELD  
PANOLA COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 20, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all overproduction for the El Paso Production Company Vera Black Well No. 8 in the Bethany (Cotton Valley) Field, Panola County, Texas, be and is hereby canceled, and that this well be and are permanently classified as a gas well.
