FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING A NET GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY  
FOR THE HITCHLAND (MORROW, LOWER) FIELD,  
HANSFORD COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 10, 2013, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all wells in the Hitchland (Morrow, Lower) Field, Hansford County, Texas, may produce under an increased net gas-to-oil ratio authority with a daily casinghead gas limit of 375 MCF per day. Oil allowables for wells in the subject field shall not be penalized unless the above permitted casinghead gas limit is exceeded.

It is further **ORDERED** that all accumulated overproduction in this field as of the date of this Final Order is canceled.
