**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING INCREASED NET GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
IN THE JOHNES (MIDDLE WLFC. DETRITAL) FIELD
UPTON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-number docket heard on October 4, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that wells in the Johnes (Middle Wlfc. Detrital) Field, Upton County, Texas, are authorized to produce under increased net gas-oil ratio authority with a casinghead gas limit of 1,100 MCFD and special oil allowable of 435 BOPD. It is further ordered that all accumulated overproduction for the Matador Operating Company - Amerind lease (14774) is hereby canceled.
