**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF XTO ENERGY, INC.  
FOR INCREASED GAS-OIL RATIO  
IN THE CARTHAGE (TRAVIS PEAK) FIELD  
HARRISON AND PANOLA COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-number docket heard on September 7, 2006, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required for which service was waived by parties of record; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the permitted gas-oil ratio for all wells in the Carthage (Travis Peak) Field, Panola and Harrison Counties, Texas, shall be 10,000 (Ten thousand) cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil produced.

It is further ordered that all overproduction in the Carthage (Travis Peak) Field is hereby cancelled.
