**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CHEVRON USA, INC.  
FOR INCREASED GAS-OIL RATIO FOR ITS  
BRUNI MINERAL TRUST LEASE WELL NO. B-31  
BRAZIL PASTURE (WILCOX SECOND) FIELD  
WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 27, 2002, and April 16, 2003, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Chevron USA, Inc., be and is hereby granted permission to produce the Bruni Mineral Trust Lease Well No. B-31 Brazil Pasture (Wilcox Second) Field, Webb County, Texas, under increased gas-oil ratio authority with a daily gas limit of 300 MCF.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all overproduction for the Chevron USA, Inc., Bruni Mineral Trust Lease Well No. B-31 in the Brazil Pasture (Wilcox Second) Field, Webb County, Texas, be and is hereby canceled.
