The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-number docket heard on September 29, 1999, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the permitted gas-oil ratio for all wells in the Ineeda (Hackberry) Field, Jefferson County, Texas, shall be a maximum of 3,000 MCF of casinghead gas per day per well.

It is further ordered that all casinghead gas produced by any well in the subject field as of the effective date of this order is hereby canceled.
