**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF EEX OPERATING, L.P.
FOR INCREASED GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
FOR ITS PLOW REALTY LEASE, WELL NOS. 6, 7 AND 8
GOLDEN PLOW (YEGUA 250) FIELD
COLORADO COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 30, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that EEX Operating, L.P., be and is hereby granted permission to produce its Plow Realty Lease Well Nos. 6, 7 and 8 in the Golden Plow (Yegua 250) Field, Colorado County, Texas, under increased gas-oil ratio authority, with a daily gas limit of 600 MCF each.

It is further **ORDERED** that all gas overproduction for the EEX Operating, L.P., Plow Realty Lease, Golden Plow (Yegua 250) Field, Colorado County, be and is hereby canceled.
