FINAL ORDER APPROVING PERMANENT GAS CLASSIFICATION FOR WELLS IN THE DE WITT (EAGLE FORD SHALE) FIELD DE WITT COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 28, 2011, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all wells completed with a gas-oil ratio of 3,000 cubic feet per barrel and above in the De Witt (Eagle Ford Shale) Field, De Witt, County, Texas, are permanently classified as gas wells without the need of further administrative review, effective the date of initial completion.
