FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF ACOCK/ANAQUA OPERATING CO. LC
FOR INCREASED GAS/OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
FOR THE THOMAS O'CONNOR LEASE WELL NO. 14
GRETA (5800) FIELD, REFUGIO COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 2, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Acock/Anaqua Operating Co. LC be and is hereby granted permission to produce the Thomas O'Connor Lease Well No. 14, Greta (5800) Field, Refugio County, Texas, under increased gas-oil ratio authority with a daily gas limit of 600 MCF.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Acock/Anaqua Operating Co. LC Thomas O'Connor Lease Well No. 14 in the Greta (5800) Field be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
