Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Marathon Oil EF LLC is hereby granted a permanent exception to Statewide Rule 32 for Flores Unit, Well No. 1H (API No. 42-013-34394), in the Eagleville (Eagle Ford-1) Field, Atascosa County, Texas. Marathon Oil EF LLC is authorized to flare up to 100 MCFGPD in Flores Unit, Well No. 1H (API No. 42-013-34394) indefinitely. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file for each well the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.

The operator shall file for each well the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
