FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
MURPHY EXPLORATION & PRODUCTION CO.-USA  
FOR EXCEPTION TO 16 TAC §3.32  
FOR ITS Y-BAR LEASE, WELL NO. 1H  
EAGLEVILLE (EAGLEFORD-1) FIELD  
MCMULLEN COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 12, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Murphy Exploration & Production Co.-USA is hereby granted an exception to 16 TAC §3.32 for its Y-Bar Lease, Well No. 1H (API 42-311-34297) in the Eagleville (Eagleford-1) Field, McMullen County, Texas. Murphy Exploration & Production Co.-USA is hereby authorized to flare up to 170 MCF of gas per day in its Y-Bar Lease, Well No. 1H from August 31, 2012 through October 05, 2012. The authority is granted provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file for each well the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
