FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF EOG RESOURCES, INC.  
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE  
GORDON TRUST LEASE  
EAGLEVILLE (EAGLE FORD-1) FIELD  
ATASCOSA COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 13, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that EOG Resources, Inc. is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Gordon Trust Lease (ID No. 15893), Eagleville (Eagle Ford-1) Field, Atascosa County, Texas. EOG Resources, Inc. is authorized to flare 90 MCFPD of casinghead gas from May 1, 2013, through May 10, 2013, from the Gordon Trust Lease. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
