**FINAL ORDER
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE
HERBST UNIT A, WELL NO. 1H
EAGLEVILLE (EAGLE FORD-1) FIELD
ATASCOSA COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 9, 2013, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Murphy Expl. & Prod. Co. - USA is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Herbst Unit (Lease No.16206), Eagleville (Eagle Ford-1) Field, Atascosa County, Texas. Murphy Expl. & Prod. Co. - USA is authorized to flare casinghead gas as follows: up to 230 MCF/D for the Herbst Unit Well No 1H, from June 5, 2013 to March 31, 2013. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for the well.
