**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF FAMCOR OIL, INC.
FOR GAS FLARING AUTHORITY FOR THE USA-RAVEN FOREST WELL NO. 1
RAVEN FOREST (11,300) FIELD,
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 19, 2007, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Famcor Oil, Inc. is authorized pursuant to Statewide Rule 32 to flare gas during testing from its USA-Raven Lease Well No. 1 for a period not to exceed 12 months from the date the well is completed (the date the well is perforated).
