**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF LEGACY RESERVES OPERATING LP
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE
UNIVERSITY CONSOLIDATED XIII TANK BATTERY
MAGUTEX (DEVONIAN) FIELD
ANDREWS COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 24, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Legacy Reserves Operating LP is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the University Consolidated XIII Tank Battery (Lease ID No. 23051), Magutex (Devonian) Field, Andrews County, Texas. Legacy Reserves Operating LP is authorized to flare 100 MCFPD of casinghead gas from the University Consolidated XIII Tank Battery from September 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
