## FINAL ORDER APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF O'RYAN OIL AND GAS FOR AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO STATEWIDE RULE 36 TO INJECT HYDROGEN SULPHIDE GAS, HENDERSON (SMACKOVER) UNIT WELL NO. 2 IN THE CHICKEN SOUP (SMACKOVER) FIELD, HENDERSON COUNTY, TEXAS
