FINAL ORDER APPROVING NEW FIELD DESIGNATION AND AUTHORITY FOR INJECTION OF FLUIDS CONTAINING HYDROGEN SULFIDE IN THE DUBOSE (UP.SPARTA-H2S DISPOSAL) FIELD GONZALES COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 1, 1999, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that a new field designation called the Dubose (Up.Sparta-H2S Disposal) Field, Gonzales County, Texas be approved. The field number is _______. The designated interval for the field shall be as follows:

The entire correlative interval from 2,100 feet to 2,500 feet as shown on the log of the H. F. Borchers No. 1, William Robertson Survey, A-396, Gonzales County, Texas shall be designated as a single reservoir and be designated as the Dubose (Up.Sparta-H2S Disposal) Field.

The H. F. Borchers No. 1 shall be transferred from the Dubose (Edwards-A-) Field to the Dubose (Up.Sparta-H2S Disposal) Field.

It is further ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the injection of fluids containing hydrogen sulfide in the H. F. Borchers No. 1 in the Dubose (Up.Sparta-H2S Disposal) Field, Gonzales County, Texas, as provided in Section (C)(10) of Rule 36 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations of Statewide Application, be and it is hereby approved.
