**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF O' RYAN OIL AND GAS  
TO AMEND PERMIT NO. F-15381 TO ALLOW DISPOSAL OF OIL AND GAS WASTE  
CONTAINING HYDROGEN SULFIDE GAS INTO A FORMATION  
PRODUCTIVE OF OIL AND GAS AND FOR AUTHORITY PURSUANT  
TO STATEWIDE RULE 36 AND 46 FOR HYDROGEN SULFIDE INJECTION  
IN THE BURNETT-SLOAN UNIT WELL NO. B2  
TROOPER (SMACKOVER) FIELD, NAVARRO COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 7, 2010, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

It is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of O' Ryan Oil and Gas to inject gas containing hydrogen sulfide into Well No. B2 on the Burnett-Sloan Unit lease, Trooper (Smackover) Field, Navarro County, Texas, be and it is hereby approved pursuant to Statewide Rule 36(c)(10)(A) and Rule 46.
