**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF LEGADO PERMIAN, LLC FOR
INJECTION OF FLUIDS CONTAINING HYDROGEN SULFIDE IN THE
GOLDSMITH-LANDRETH SAN ANDRES UNIT
GOLDSMITH FIELD
ECTOR COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 8, 2010, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Legado Permian, LLC is hereby authorized to inject fluids containing hydrogen sulfide into 20 injection wells (Nos. 125W, 126R, 128W, 129R, 151W, 152W, 153W, 154W, 175W, 176W, 177W, 178R, 201W, 202W, 203W, 204R, 223W, 224W, 225W and 226W) on the Goldsmith-Landreth San Andres Unit (Lease Id. No. 17491), Goldsmith Field, Ector County, Texas, pursuant to Statewide Rule 36(c)(10)(A)(ii).
