## FINAL ORDER APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF OCCIDENTAL PERMIAN LTD. FOR INJECTION OF FLUIDS CONTAINING HYDROGEN SULFIDE IN VARIOUS WELLS ON THE DENVER UNIT WASSON FIELD GAINES COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 23, 2006, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Occidental Permian Ltd. be and is hereby authorized to include fluids containing hydrogen sulfide in its injection permits for the Denver Unit Lease, Well Nos. 7417WC, 7421WC, 7509WC, 7510WC, 7511WC, 7513WC, 7514WC, 7515WC, 7521WC, 7530WC, 7535WC and 7536WC, as specified in the programs set out in detail in public hearing as provided in Section (C)(10) of Rule 36 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations of Statewide application, Wasson Field, Gaines County, Texas.
