FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that, after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket, heard on January 29, 2009, the examiners have made and filed a report containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, which was served on all parties of record, and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the proposal for decision and the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Commission that the location of the Burlington Resources O & G Co., L.P., T-Bar-X/Shaw Lease, Well No. 1, Savell (Bossier Sand) Field, as shown by the as-drilled plat submitted by the applicant is **REASONABLE** and the T-Bar-X/Shaw Lease, Well No. 1 well as-drilled is in **SUBSTANTIAL COMPLIANCE** with drilling permit 618739.

It is further **ORDERED** that the T-Bar-X/Shaw Lease, Well No. 1 should be assigned an allowable in accordance with Commission rules.
