**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING INCREASED NET GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY  
FOR THE KOONTZ (RUSSELL) FIELD,  
VICTORIA COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on January 7, 2010, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that operators are hereby granted permission to produce wells in the Koontz (Russell) Field, Victoria County, Texas, under increased net gas-oil ratio authority with a casinghead gas limit of 450 MCFD. It is further ordered the subject well's oil allowable shall not be penalized unless the above permitted casinghead gas limit is exceeded. It is further ordered that all accumulated overproduction for wells in this field is canceled.

It is further ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the maximum daily oil allowable for a well in the field shall be 102 barrels as determined by the applicable 1947 yardstick allowable.
