**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF LGDC CORPORATION  
TO ESTABLISH THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION  
FOR THE ELEANOR SHERRON LEASE WELL NO. 1  
INEEDA (NODOSARIA B) FIELD  
JEFFERSON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 23, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of LGDC Corporation be and is hereby granted to establish that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for its Eleanor Sherron Lease Well No. 1 in the Ineeda (Nodosaria B) Field, Jefferson County, Texas, is 400 barrels of oil per day with a daily gas limit of 800 MCF.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the LGDC Corporation Eleanor Sherron Lease, Well No. 1, in the Ineeda (Nodosaria B) Field be canceled.
