FINAL ORDER APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF DEVON ENERGY PRODUCTION CO. L.P. FOR MER ALLOWABLE AND INCREASED NET GAS/OIL RATIO FOR THE T.S. SCHROEDER LEASE, WELL NO. 6 AGUA DULCE (6650) FIELD NUECES COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on March 26, 2003, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Devon Energy Production Co. L.P. be and is hereby granted permission to produce the T.S. Schroeder Lease, Well No. 6, Agua Dulce (6650) Field, Nueces County, Texas, under an MER allowable with a daily oil limit of 200 barrels and increased gas-oil ratio authority with a daily gas limit of 1.5 MMCF.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Devon Energy Production Co. L.P.-T.S. Schroeder Lease, Well No. 6, in the Agua Dulce (6650) Field, be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
