**FINAL ORDER
ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION
FOR THE HUNT OIL COMPANY, V.T. AMACKER WELLS NO. 77-2 & 77-7
IN THE AMACKER-TIPPETT, SW (9100) FIELD, UPTON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 17, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which was service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production for the Hunt Oil Company, V.T. Amacker Lease Well No. 77-2 is established at 625 BOPD and for Well No. 77-7 is established at 520 BOPD in the Amacker-Tippett, SW (9100) Field, Upton County, Texas.

It is further ordered that all overproduction for the subject wells is hereby canceled.
