**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF HUNT OIL COMPANY
TO ESTABLISH AN MER
FOR ITS AMACKER-TIPPETT "A" POOL UNIT LEASE WELL NO. 10
AMACKER-TIPPETT, SW. (WOLFCAMP A) FIELD
UPTON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 26, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Hunt Oil Company is granted such that its Amacker-Tippett "A" Pool Unit Lease Well No. 10 in the Amacker-Tippett, SW. (Wolfcamp A) Field, Upton County, Texas, be and is hereby allowed to produce up to 535 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Hunt Oil Company Amacker-Tippett "A" Pool Unit Lease Well No. 10 in the Amacker-Tippett, SW. (Wolfcamp A) Field, Upton County, be and is hereby canceled.
