**FINAL ORDER  
ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION  
FOR THE BARNETT-AMACKER LEASE WELL NO. 9  
SPRABERRY (TREND AREA) FIELD  
UPTON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 30, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the Southwest Royalties, Inc. - Barnett-Amacker Lease Well No. 9 (API No. 42-461-35681) in the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field, Upton County, Texas, is 400 BOPD.

It is further ordered that all overproduction for the Barnett-Amacker Lease Well No. 9 (API No. 42-461-35681) in the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field is hereby canceled.
