**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY
FOR INCREASED GAS/OIL RATIO AUTHORITY AND
MER DETERMINATION
EMBAR AND FRANK "B" LEASES
GOLDSMITH (CLEAR FORK) AND GOLDSMITH (5600) FIELDS
ANDREWS AND ECTOR COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 19, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Phillips Petroleum Company be and is hereby granted to allow each well on the Embar and Frank "B" Leases, Goldsmith (Clear Fork) and Goldsmith (5600) Fields, Andrews and Ector Counties, Texas, to produce under increased gas-oil ratio authority with a daily gas limit of 1575 MCF; and to allow each of these wells to produce up to 450 barrels of oil per day, the most efficient rate of production at the current time.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for wells on the Phillips Petroleum Company Embar and Frank "B" Leases, Goldsmith (Clear Fork) and Goldsmith (5600) Fields, Andrews and Ector Counties, Texas be and is hereby canceled.
