**FINAL ORDER  
ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION  
FOR THE ARNWINE -WILSON UNIT NO. 1  
IN THE HAMILTON (CANYON) FIELD  
HOCKLEY COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 21, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the Wheeler Operating Corporation - Arnwine-Wilson Unit Well No. 1 (67728) in the Hamilton (Canyon) Field, Hockley County, Texas, is established at 300 BOPD. It is further ordered that all overproduction for the Arnwine-Wilson Unit Well No. 1 is hereby canceled.
