**FINAL ORDER
ESTABLISHING AN MER ALLOWABLE
FOR THE BEN LEASE, WELL NO. 1
SMITH (SPRABERRY) FIELD
DAWSON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 30, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the Raw Oil & Gas, Inc., Ben Lease, Well No. 1 (API No. 42-305-30510), in the Smith (Spraberry) Field, is 200 barrels of oil per day

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Raw Oil & Gas, Inc., Ben Lease, Well No. 1 in the Smith (Spraberry) Field is hereby canceled.
