FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
WEST BAY EXPLORATION COMPANY
FOR MER ALLOWABLE
FOR THE SICKING "B" LEASE, WELL NO. 1
CAHOON (ELLENBURGER) FIELD
COOKE COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 8, 2003, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that West Bay Exploration Company be and is hereby granted permission to produce the Sicking "B" Lease, Well No. 1, Cahoon (Ellenburger) Field, Cooke County, Texas, under an MER allowable with a daily oil limit of 120 barrels.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the West Bay Exploration Company Sicking "B" Lease, Well No. 1, in the Cahoon (Ellenburger) Field, be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
