**FINAL ORDER  
CONSIDERING A MOST EFFICIENT RATE ALLOWABLE  
AND DAILY GAS LIMIT  
FOR THE MANGOLD TRACT 23, WELL NO. 1  
K-M-A (STRAWN REEF) FIELD  
ARCHER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 24, 2013, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Stephens & Johnson Operating Co. is hereby granted permission to produce the Mangold Tract 23 Lease (No. 32437), Well No. 1 (API # 42-009-42490) in the K-M-A (Strawn Reef) Field, Wichita County, Texas, under a Maximum Efficient Rate allowable of 300 BOPD and a daily gas limit of 400 MCFPD. It is further ordered that all accumulated overproduction for this lease is canceled.
