FINAL ORDER APPROVING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION AND INCREASED NET GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY FOR THE CAMPBELL LEASE WELL NO. 2216 MENDOTA, NW. (GRANITE WASH) FIELD HEMPHILL COUNTY. TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 23, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the Campbell Lease Well No. 2216 (API No. 42-211-34014) in the Mendota, NW. (Granite Wash) Field, Hemphill County, Texas, is established at 750 BOPD. In addition, Samson Lone Star, LLC is granted permission to produce the Campbell Lease Well No. 2216 (API No. 42-211-34014) in the Mendota, NW. (Granite Wash) Field, Hemphill County, Texas under increased net gas-oil ratio authority with a casinghead gas limit of 2,400 MCFGPD.

It is further ordered that all overproduction for this well in the Mendota, NW. (Granite Wash) Field is hereby cancelled.
