FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION  
FOR THE APACHE CORPORATION BIVINS-LIT, BIVINS-WEST,  
AND BOYS RANCH 116 LEASES  
PAINT RIDGE (CANYON GRANITE WASH) FIELD  
OLDHAM COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 02, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the Apache Corporation, Bivins-Lit (RRC Lease ID No. 08366), Bivins-West (RRC Lease ID No. 08507), and Boys Ranch 116 (RRC Lease ID No. 08536) Leases, Paint Ridge (Canyon Granite Wash) Field, Oldham County, Texas, is established at 1,700 barrels of oil per day per well.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction in the Bivins-Lit (RRC Lease ID No. 08366), Bivins-West (RRC Lease ID No. 08507), and Boys Ranch 116 (RRC Lease ID No. 08536) Leases, Paint Ridge (Canyon Granite Wash) Field, Oldham County, Texas, Wood County, Texas, is hereby canceled.
