**FINAL ORDER
COMBINING THE MIKESKA (MASSIVE WILCOX) FIELD
INTO THE MIKESKA, SW. (WILCOX 12600) FIELD
AND ADOPTING SPECIAL FIELD RULES TO GOVERN THE
MIKESKA, SW. (WILCOX 12600) FIELD
LIVE OAK COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 6, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Mikeska, SW. (Wilcox 12600) and Mikeska (Massive Wilcox) Fields, located in Live Oak County, Texas, be and they are hereby combined and recognized as one field, to be known as the Mikeska, SW. (Wilcox 12600) Field; and from and after said effective date, all records and reports filed with the Commission will show such designation.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Commission that the operating rules as hereinafter set out are hereby adopted for the Mikeska, SW. (Wilcox 12600) Field, Live Oak County, Texas.

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval from 12,775 feet to 13,540 feet as shown on the Induction-Density log of the Greenbrier Operating Company (now Wynn-Crosby Energy, Inc.), Bonilla Lease Well No. 1, Eduardo Ramirez Survey, Live Oak County, Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Mikeska, SW. (Wilcox 12600) Field.

RULE 2: The daily allowable production of gas from individual wells completed in a non-associated gas reservoir of the subject field shall be determined by allocating the allowable production, after deductions have been made for wells which are incapable of producing their gas allowables, among the individual wells in the following manner:

FIVE percent (5%) of the total field allowable shall be allocated equally among the individual prorable wells producing from this field.

NINETY-FIVE percent (95%) of the total field allowable shall be allocated among the individual wells in the proportion that the deliverability of such well, as evidenced by the most recent G-10 test filed with the Railroad Commission bears to the summation of the deliverability of all proratable wells producing from this field.
