**FINAL ORDER  
COMBINING THE SNOWDEN (SPRABERRY) FIELD  
INTO THE FELKEN (SPRABERRY) FIELD  
DAWSON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 18, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Snowden (Spraberry) and Felken (Spraberry) Fields, located in Dawson County, Texas, be and they are hereby combined and recognized as one field, to be known as the Felken (Spraberry) Field, Dawson County, Texas; and from and after said effective date, all records and reports filed with the Commission will show such designation.
