**FINAL ORDER  
ADOPTING FIELD RULES FOR THE  
MORAY (EDWARDS) FIELD  
DE WITT COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 5, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the following rules shall be adopted for the Moray (Edwards) Field, De Witt County, Texas.

**RULE 1:** No gas well shall hereafter be drilled nearer than THREE HUNDRED THIRTY (330) feet to any property line, lease line, or subdivision line and no well shall be drilled nearer than THREE HUNDRED THIRTY (330) feet to any applied for, permitted or completed well in the same reservoir on the same lease, pooled unit or unitized tract. The aforementioned distances are the minimum distances to allow an operator flexibility in locating a well. Provided however, that the Commission will grant exceptions to permit drilling within shorter distances and drilling more wells than herein prescribed whenever the Commission shall have determined that such exceptions are necessary either to prevent waste or to prevent the confiscation of property. When exception to these rules is desired, application therefor shall be filed and will be acted upon in accordance with the provisions of Commission Statewide Rule 37, which applicable provisions of said rule is incorporated herein by reference.

In applying this rule, the general order of the Commission with relation to the subdivision of property shall be observed.

Notwithstanding the above, there shall be no minimum requirement for between well spacing between horizontal and vertical wells and operators shall be required to file an as-drilled plat showing the path, penetration point and terminus of all drainholes in horizontal wells.
