**FINAL ORDER
RESCINDING THE FIELD RULES
IN THE ASHFORD, YEGUA FIELD
LAVACA COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after staff review in the above-numbered docket reviewed on November 18, 2009, the examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.
