## FINAL ORDER CONTINUING THE TEMPORARY FIELD RULES FOR THE SUGARKANE (EAGLE FORD) FIELD BEE, KARNES AND LIVE OAK COUNTIES, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on December 22, 2011, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Temporary Field Rules adopted in Final Order No. 02-0264837, effective June 22, 2010, for the Sugarkane (Eagle Ford) Field, Bee, Karnes and Live Oak Counties, Texas, are to be continued as temporary for an additional eighteen months.

It is further **ORDERED** that these rules are temporary and effective until December 22, 2014, or until Commission staff evaluates appropriate data after notice and opportunity for hearing as offered by the Commission prior to the expiration of the rules. After this notice and opportunity for hearing, should the evidence evaluated during review be insufficient to sustain spacing or proration unit rules, these temporary rules, on the Commission's own motion, may be modified or terminated.
