## FINAL ORDER AMENDING FIELD RULE 1 FOR THE POK-A-DOT (8600) FIELD ZAPATA AND WEBB COUNTIES, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 17, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rule 1 of the field rules for the Pok-A-Dot (8600) Field, adopted in Final Order No. 4-70,547, effective November 27, 1978, as amended, is hereby amended as set out below:

**RULE 1:** No well shall hereafter be drilled nearer than FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN (467) feet to any property line, lease line, or subdivision line. There is no betweenwell spacing limitation in this field.

It is further ordered that the allocation formula for the field shall remain suspended. The allocation formula may be reinstated administratively, in accordance with the Commission's rules, if the market demand for gas in the Pok-A-Dot (8600) Field drops below 100% of deliverability.
