**FINAL ORDER
AMENDING RULE 1 OF THE FIELD RULES FOR
THE NUECES BAY DEEP CONSOLIDATED FIELD,
SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 4, 2009, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered that Rule 1 of the field rules adopted in Final Order No. 04-0219171, effective June 2, 1998, as amended, for the Nueces Bay Deep Consolidated Field, San Patricio County, Texas, is hereby amended as follows:

RULE 1: The entire combined correlative interval from 9,630 feet TVD to 12,350 feet TVD as shown on the log of the EOG Resources, Inc., State Tract 692 et al Unit Well No. 1 (API No. 42-409-32905), Section 4, J. N. Seguin Survey, A-246, San Patricio County, Texas shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Nueces Bay Deep Consolidated Field.
