FINAL ORDER AMENDING FIELD RULE NO. 2 FOR THE HAYNES (HINNANT CONS.) FIELD ZAPATA COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on March 7, 2012, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Field Rule No. 2 adopted in Final Order No. No. 04-0221750, effective June 29, 1999, for the Haynes (Hinnant Cons.) Field, Zapata County, Texas, is hereby amended. The amended Field Rule No. 2 is set out as follows:

RULE 2: No well for oil or gas shall hereafter be drilled nearer than THREE HUNDRED THIRTY (330) feet to any property line, lease line or subdivision line. There is no minimum between well spacing limitation. The aforementioned distances in the above rule are minimum distances to allow an operator flexibility in locating a well, and the above spacing rule and the other rules to follow are for the purpose of permitting only one well to each drilling and proration unit. Provided however, that the Commission will grant exceptions to permit drilling within shorter distances and drilling more wells than herein prescribed whenever the Commission shall have determined that such exceptions are necessary either to prevent waste or to prevent the confiscation of property. When exception to these rules is desired, application therefore shall be filed and will be acted upon in accordance with the provisions of Commission Statewide Rules 37 and 38, which applicable provisions of said rule are incorporated herein by reference. The standard drilling unit shall remain FORTY (40) acres.

In applying this rule the general order of the Commission with relation to the subdivision of property shall be observed.

It is further **ORDERED** that the allocation formula in the Haynes (Hinnant Cons.) Field shall remain suspended. The allocation formula may be reinstated administratively, in accordance with the Commission's rules, if the market demand for gas in the Haynes (Hinnant Cons.) Field drops below 100% of deliverability.
