#### **EXAMINER'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Pioneer Natural Res. USA, Inc. requests that Rule 1 of the field rules for the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field be amended. The current rule is as follows:

1. Designation of the field as the correlative interval from 6,307 feet to 10,159 feet as shown on the log of the Amacker 67 Well No. 1.

Pioneer requests that Rule 1 be amended as follows:

1. Designation of the field as the correlative interval from 6,865 feet to 10,605 feet as shown on the log of the Houpt Well No. 1.

Pioneer further requests that the Commission approve a blanket Rule 10 exception for any well in the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field and any of the 150 Strawn fields listed on Attachment A.

This application was unprotested and the examiner recommends approval of the requested rule change and the requested Rule 10 authority.

# **DISCUSSION OF THE EVIDENCE**

The Spraberry (Trend Area) Field covers approximately 2 million acres in portions of nine counties in the Midland Basin. In 1993, the field interval for the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field was defined based on the log of the Houpt No. 1. At that time, the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field designation did not include the Clearfork interval above the Spraberry formation. In 2007, the correlative interval for the field was amended to include the Clearfork. The current interval is from 6,307 feet to 10,159 feet based on the log of the Amacker 67 Well No. 1. This interval includes the Clearfork, Spraberry, Dean and Wolfcamp formations. However, the base of the correlative interval is not inclusive of the entire Wolfcamp. Pioneer now seeks to amend the designated interval to clarify that the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field extends to the top of the Strawn formation. This is more clearly demonstrated on the log of the Houpt No. 1 than the Amacker 67 No. 1. The proposed interval from 6,865 feet to 10,605 feet as shown on the log of the Houpt No. 1 includes the entire Wolfcamp. The amended field designation will make correlations easier because the top of the Strawn is easily recognized.

Pioneer has identified 150 Strawn fields in the geographic area covered by the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field. These Strawn fields include both oil and gas fields, many of which do not have any wells currently on the proration schedule. Pioneer has identified 106 Rule 10 exceptions which have been previously approved by the Commission for the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field and some of the Strawn fields now proposed for Rule 10 exception.

A typical completion in the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field is capable of initially producing about 55 BOPD. A typical Strawn completion is expected to initially produce at a rate of about 20 BOPD. Any commingled completion will likely require artificial lift, therefore eliminating any cross-flow problems between zones.

The Spraberry (Trend Area) Field is being actively developed. Between May 2008 and April 2010, 1,600 wells were drilled in the field and production increased from 90,000 BOPD to 120,000 BOPD. It is expected that this development will continue with infill drilling.

On average, a Spraberry well will ultimately recover approximately 95,000 BO and a Strawn well will recover approximately 15,000 BO. A stand-alone Strawn completion is not economic in many cases. As a result of commingling, incremental reserves of approximately 18,000 BO will be produced as a result of the lower combined economic limit.

It is requested that wells which are downhole commingled in the subject fields be assigned to the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field for proration purposes.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Notice of this hearing was issued to all operators in all of the subject fields.
- 2. The Spraberry (Trend Area) Field is currently designated as the correlative interval from 6,307 feet to 10,159 feet as shown on the log of the Amacker 67 Well No. 1. The base of the interval is in the Wolfcamp, approximately 40 feet above the top of the Strawn formation.
- 3. To ease in correlations of the base of the correlative interval for the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field, the field interval should be defined as the interval from 6,865 feet to 10,605 feet as shown on the log of the Houpt Well No. 1. The interval extends from the Clearfork marker to the top of the Strawn, including the Strawn, Spraberry, Dean and Wolfcamp formations.
- 4. There are at least 150 Strawn fields in the geographic area covered by the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field.
- 5. At least 106 Rule 10 exceptions have been approved by the Commission for the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field and many of the Strawn fields now proposed for Rule 10 exception.
- 6. Cross-flow between the fields is not expected. The wells will likely require artificial lift.
- 7. Downhole commingling production from these fields will result in the recovery of incremental reserves from the various fields proposed for commingling zones. It is estimated that an additional 18,000 BO per well will be recovered as a result of commingling.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Proper notice was issued as required by all applicable codes and regulatory statutes.
- 2. All things have occurred and been accomplished to give the Commission jurisdiction in this matter.
- 3. Amending the correlative interval for the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field is necessary to prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
- 4. Approval of the requested Rule 10 exceptions for all wells in the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field and the Strawn fields listed on Attachment A will prevent waste and will not harm correlative rights.

# **EXAMINER'S RECOMMENDATION**

Based on the above findings and conclusions, the examiner recommends approval of the requested change to Rule 1 of the field rules for the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field and approval of Rule 10 exceptions for all wells in the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field and the Strawn fields listed on Attachment A.

Such applications may be approved without notice and hearing. This provision shall apply to the following fields:
