**FINAL ORDER
AMENDING FIELD RULES
AND MAKING THE AMENDED RULES PERMANENT
FOR THE SAINT WILMA (STRAWN) FIELD
ANDREWS COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 29, 2010, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rule 1 of the field rules for the Saint Wilma (Strawn) Field, adopted in Final Order No. 08-0259900, effective January 16, 2009, is amended as hereafter set out.

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval from 7,225 feet to 11,042 feet as shown on the log of the University Brittany Well No. 1, API No. 003-38989, Section 11, Block 3, University Lands Survey, Andrews County, Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Saint Wilma (Strawn) Field.

It is further ordered that the field rules, as amended, are hereby made permanent for the Saint Wilma (Strawn) Field, Andrews County, Texas
