## FINAL ORDER AMENDING FIELD RULES FOR THE ST. CLAIR (GRANITE WASH) FIELD ROBERTS COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 18, 2009, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rule 1 of the field rules adopted in Final Order No. 10-0209552, effective September 19, 1995, for the St. Clair (Granite Wash) Field, Roberts County, Texas is amended as hereafter set out:

**RULE 1**: The entire correlative interval from 8,800 feet to 10,448 feet as shown on the log of the Christie-Tipps No. 1, (API No. 393 00196), Section 78, Block B-1, H & GN Survey, Roberts County, Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the St. Clair (Granite Wash) Field.

It is further ordered that Form P-15 and plat shall not be required for wells in this field as long as acreage is not a factor in the allocation formula.
