**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On June 14, 2006, CIMA Energy, Ltd. (“CIMA”) filed with the Railroad Commission of Texas (“Commission”) a complaint against TEPPCO Crude Oil Pipeline, L.P. (“TEPPCO”) alleging discriminatory conduct by TEPPCO, a common carrier pipeline. On July 17, 2007 the Commission entered a final order in this docket and TEPPCO filed a timely motion for rehearing. On October 2, 2007, CIMA and TEPPCO filed a Joint Motion to Grant Rehearing and Dismiss. The motion recites that the parties have settled the complaint and requests that this docket be dismissed with prejudice.

It is accordingly Ordered that TEPPCO’s motion for rehearing is granted and the complaint in this docket is hereby **DISMISSED**, with prejudice, under the provisions of 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.126(3) (1991), on this the 9th day of October, 2007.
