**FINAL ORDER
CONSIDERING A MOST EFFICIENT RATE ALLOWABLE
FOR THE GEO. H. SPEER LEASE, WELL NO. 25, SUN (G-1) FIELD,
STARR COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 9, 2014, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Geo. H. Speer Lease Well No. 25 (API No. 427-34658, Lease No. 13794) in the Sun (G-1) Field, Starr County, Texas, may be produced under a Maximum Efficient Rate allowable of 150 BOPD.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all overproduction on the Geo. H. Speer Lease (No. 13794) is hereby cancelled.
